I recall running between two teaching jobs and stopping in at Mountainside--I found Mrs. D. in the Recovery room--she was overwhelmed to see me and her daughter was taken back that somehow I managed to get to her before she did. In any event I never forgot that. After Mrs. D. retired, I remembered January 12th--it became a day that I could never forget--making the phone call to Mrs. D. in advance trying to coordinate the time to bring over her birthday cake. I was always greeted, of course, by "Nicky" her loving dog. Years would pass, but that birthday cake and January 12th became our yearly tradition. Mrs. D would always follow up with a thank you card and sometimes the phone would ring while I was sitting at her kitchen table eating some cake and talking. Mrs. D would always say to who she was talking to on the phone that her friend is here and brings me my birthday cake each year and he never forgets me.

Needless to say Mrs. D. you are now with the angels looking down from heaven at all of us. We will miss you so much and my heart is very saddened to hear of your passing.
