September 20, 1922 - October 19, 2015

Edward Joseph Gronek, 93, of Rochelle Park, passed away Monday, October 19, 2015, at the New Jersey Veterans Home in Paramus. He was born in Garfield, lived in Lodi, before moving to Rochelle Park 40 years ago. He was an Assembly Machinist for Sun Chemical Company in Rutherford for over 35 years retiring in 1984. He was a veteran of the United States Navy serving in WW II aboard the USS Iowa and earned the Philippine Liberation Medal with 2 Bronze Stars, Asiatic-Pacific Medal with 8 Bronze Stars, and American Theater Victory Medal. He was a member of the Rochelle Park American Legion Post 170 and member of the Veterans Association of the USS Iowa. Edward was a parishioner of Sacred Heart R.C.
