



## Edward Paul Kamienski

October 8, 1946 - August 15, 2023

Edward Paul Kamienski, Jr (76) passed away after a long battle with Alzheimer / Dementia on August 15, 2023.

He was born in Passaic, New Jersey on October 8, 1946. He is a graduate of Ramsey HS in New Jersey. Edward had a degree in Biomedical Engineering from New York Institute of Technology as well as being a licensed Practitioner of Mortuary Science. From a article in papers throughout the Northeast: Edward was an inventor: of the first automatic instrument for diagnosing diseases of the blood and immunological system. Edward started and completed the invention during four months at the Hyland Research Laboratory in Los Angeles. Because of pending patent search at that time, Edward could not disclose how his machine works. However, Dr. Edward Shanbron, medical and research director at Hyland said: Edward was instrumental in developing a new piece of laboratory equipment which I think will have widespread usage in hospital laboratories in the future and is a real contribution to medical sciences. His machine will be used to implement theories on the treatment of hemophilia.

Edward is survived by his brother George Howard Kamienski; sister Jane Kamienski; cousin, Paul Kamienski. Edward will also be lovingly remembered buy many other relatives and friends throughout the USA..

Edward was cremated privately in Florida and was interred at the family plot in St. Nicholas Cemetery in Lodi, NJ.

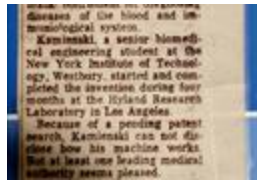
