



## Rev. Edward Peter Szpiech

November 24, 1941 - June 3, 2019

Reverend Edward Peter Szpiech, 77, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Monday, June 3, 2019. Born in Newark, Father Ed was raised in Irvington and attended Archbishop Walsh High School, then Seton Hall University for 4 years, followed by 4 years at Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology. Father Ed was ordained on May 27, 1967 and served at St. Adalbert R.C. Church in Elizabeth until 1990, when he began his long-time tenure at St. Stanislaus Kostka R.C. Church in Garfield. He was the Pastor for over 28 years, retiring on July, 1 2018. Father Ed settled in St. John Vianney Residence in Rutherford for his retirement. He was truly a beloved, integral part of the Garfield community and will be sorely missed by all who crossed his path. Father Ed served as the Chaplain for the Garfield Volunteer Fire and Police Departments for many years prior to his retirement. Father Ed was the beloved son of the late Peter and Lottie (Kwiatkowski) Szpiech, dear brother of Walter and his wife Betty, of Stanhope, loving uncle of Diane Fattorusso and her husband Hank, of Stanhope, and Cheryl Kozubal and her husband Adam, of Somerset, and great uncle to Andrea, Marissa, Lauren, Jenna and Emma.

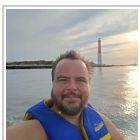

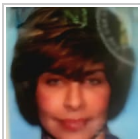
