



Ferdinand E. "Fred" Dzwilewski

January 26, 1924 - January 22, 2014

Ferdinand E. "Fred" Dzwilewski, 89, died Wednesday, January 22, 2014. Born in Garfield, January 26, 1924, to the late Andrew and Angela (Piela) Dzwilewski, Fred has been a lifetime resident. Prior to his retirement in 1986, Fred was a pharmaceutical technician for Hoffman LaRoche in Nutley, and was a member of the Roche Retirement Club. Fred was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving in the European Theater of Operations 83rd Division, 273rd Infantry, during WW II. He was awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart, with Oak Leaf Cluster, Meritorious Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Occupation Medal, and Infantry Combat Badge. He also received five combat stars for serving in Ardennes, Central Europe, Normandy, Northern France, and Rhineland. He was awarded the "Jubilee of Liberty" gold medal for the Normandy Invasion from Congressman E. Scott Garre, the United States member of the House of Representatives, Washington, D.C. Gary Engler, Veterans Affairs for New Jersey, Department of Military and Veteran Affairs Certificate Appreciation, during the administration of Thomas Kean, Governor of New Jersey. Fred was a lifetime member of the Garfield Benda Roehrich V.F.W. Post 2867, and was a member of the Ridgewood Art Institute of Fine Arts. He was a parishioner of St. Stanislaus Kostka R.C. Church in Garfield, and was a member of its Holy Name Society. Fred was the beloved husband of 52 years to Sophia (nee Zaremba), devoted father of David Dzwilewski, and his wife Kathy, of Saddle Brook, loving grandfather of Kayla and Karlie Dzwilewski, dear brother of Genevieve and Ann Dzwilewski,

and the late Thaddeus and Francis Dzwilewski.
