James L. Lett Jr., 54, passed away on Wednesday, September 9th at Hackensack University Medical Center after a yearlong battle with Leukemia. 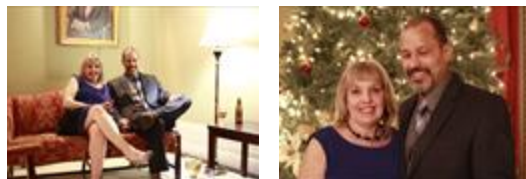
