Jane Kolano Yowik, 92, of Hudson, FL., passed away Friday, April 15, 2016. Born in Passaic, Jane lived there before moving to Garfield as a teenager, remaining there until moving to Hudson, FL., in 2002 as a "snowbird" and then a full time resident. Jane graduated Garfield High School, and received her Registered Nursing degree from St. Elizabeth's School of Nursing in Elizabeth, NJ. She completed her nurses' training in the U.S. Navy during WW II. She was a nursing supervisor at Beth Israel Hospital in Passaic, a school nurse for the Garfield Board of Education, and a doctor's office nurse for several physicians in Garfield until her retirement at age 78. Jane is a parishioner of St. Stanislaus Kostka R.C. Church in Garfield, and was Past President of the English Rosary Society for many years before moving to Hudson. Jane was the beloved wife of the late Alexander J. Yowik, devoted mother of Sandra Thomasson, and her husband Robert, of Dewitt, MI., and Valerie Mauriello, and her husband Anthony, of Ridgewood, loving grandmother of Tracy Trauscht, Heather Hudson, and Dana Mauriello, and five great-grandchildren, dear sister of Helen Kapusta and Stephanie Brozyna, who were also her closest friends and supporters. Jane is also predeceased by sister-in-law Wanda Maciaszek, and brothers-in-law Walter Maciaszek, Walter Kapusta, Peter Brozyna, and David Dikeman, and survived by several loving nieces and nephews.
