



John Henry Sobczak

March 22, 1935 - March 26, 2022

John Henry Sobczak, 87, of North Fort Myers, FL passed away on Saturday, March 26, 2022. Born in Krosniewice, Poland, on March 22, 1935, John and his family were involuntarily deported to Germany to serve as forced laborers during World War II. Following his emigration to the United States in 1949, John lived in Waymart, PA for 1 year before moving to New Jersey. He lived in Passaic, Wallington, and Paterson until 2000 when he settled in North Fort Myers, FL.

A printer, typesetter and pressman, John started his professional career in New York City, working for the Polish Daily Paper from 1952 - 1960, then for Slovak Catholic Sokol in Passaic for 28 years, and Globe Photo Engraving in Little Ferry for 3 years, retiring in 2000. John was a parishioner of Holy Rosary R.C. Church in Passaic and St. Brendan R.C. Church in Clifton. A proud veteran of the United States Army, John also was a member of the Polish Youth American Association and a director of the Polish Peoples Home, both in Wallington.

John's passions in life included travel and telling stories and jokes. John was the beloved husband of Grazyna Sobczak (nee Ozimkowski), devoted father of Eugene Sobczak and Isabella Tremper and her husband, Curtis, dear

brother of the late Regina Ratecki and Jessica Maluszczak, loving grandfather of Julia, Natalie and Christopher, uncle of Teresa and Edward, Christine, Irene, and Diana, Michelle, Denise and the late Irene H. Rzezzycki Maurello. John was preceded in death by his first wife Barbara Sobczak (nee Zyczynska), mother of Isabella and Eugene.
