John was born in Passaic, lived in Wallington most of his life, recently moving back earlier this year. He was a 1982 graduate of St. Mary's High School in Rutherford. John was a Pharmaceutical Operator for Hoffman LaRoche in Nutley, and most recently a Senior Aseptic Technician at Genzyme in Ridgefield from 1997 to present. He was a proud member of the N.R.A., a New York State Registered Hunting and Fishing Guide, and a Coast Guard Captain.
