Louis Krzych, 93, lifetime resident of Garfield, passed away at home Monday, March 20, 2017. Louis was a graduate of the University of Michigan, where he earned a degree in Engineering, and was also a member of its Alumni Association. He was a Mechanical Engineer at the Picatinny Arsenal in Dover for 30 years retiring in 1985. He was a disabled veteran of the United States Army serving in WWII, was a member of the Disabled American Veterans (DAV), was an avid St. Louis Cardinal baseball fan, and loved golfing. He was a parishioner of St. Stanislaus Kostka R.C. Church in Garfield, and a former member and associate of the Chopin Singing Society. 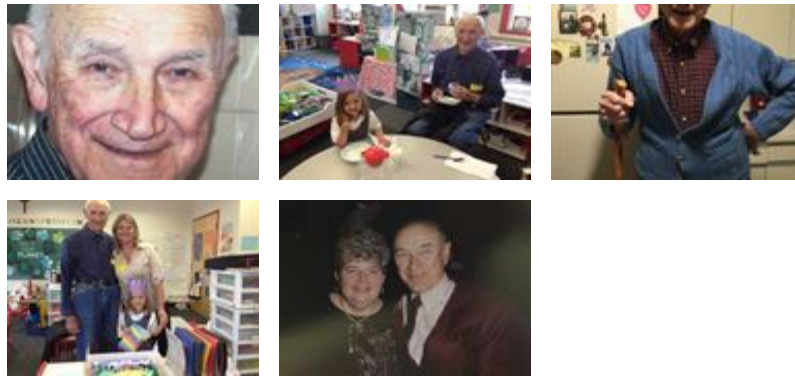
