Malgorzata Iskra, born on November 11, 1945, in the village of Siepietnica, Poland, passed on December 10, 2025. A devoted wife, mother, sister, and friend, Malgorzata lived a life centered on family, faith, and the joy she found in caring for others.

Born and raised on her family's farm in Siepietnica, Malgorzata grew up with strong values of hard work, gratitude, and kindness. In 1972, she married the love of her life, Stanislaw Iskra, Sr. A year later, in 1973, she courageously emigrated to the United States, building their new life first in Garfield, New Jersey, and later moving to Saddle Brook in 2024.

Malgorzata was a woman of remarkable commitment, both to her family and her work. Over the years, she held several positions, beginning at Presto Lock in Garfield before choosing to stay home to lovingly raise her children. She later worked in sewing, followed by an overnight quality control position at Kodak/Qualex in Fair Lawn beginning in 1994. Her final employment was with Central Furs Storage in Garfield, where she specialized in fur coat repair for 13 years before retiring in 2018. Her skill, patience, and attention to detail made her deeply valued in every workplace.

A faithful parishioner of St. Stanislaus Kostka Roman Catholic Church in Garfield, Malgorzata's spirituality was a quiet but guiding presence in her life.

She was happiest when surrounded by family and friends, especially in the kitchen. Known for her delicious cooking and baking, she loved hosting gatherings, sharing meals, and offering warmth and hospitality to all who entered her home. Malgorzata's constant smile, generous heart, and willingness to lend a helping hand made her beloved by everyone who had the privilege of knowing her.

Malgorzata is survived by her cherished son, Stanley M. Iskra Jr.; her loving sisters, Maria and Helena; and many dear nieces and nephews in both Poland and the United States. She is also mourned by countless friends whose lives were brightened by her kindness. She is predeceased by her husband, Stanislaw Iskra, Sr.; her son, Peter Iskra; her parents, Andrzej and Anna (née Dykas) Sokolowski; and her sisters Sabina and Zyta.
