



## Martin M. Scheffler

November 8, 1941 - February 24, 2026

Martin M. Scheffler, 84, passed away peacefully on February 24, 2026.

Born on November 8, 1941, in Shundra, Romania, Martin's early life was shaped by perseverance and courage. In 1945, his family relocated to Austria, and in 1951 he came to the United States in search of new opportunities and a brighter future. He first settled in Garfield, New Jersey, later moving to Saddle Brook in 1995, and ultimately finding his home in Barnegat, New Jersey in 2005.

Martin was the beloved son of the late Jacob Scheffler and the late Teresia (Mutter) Scheffler. He was predeceased by his parents and by his nephew, Robert Unger.

A proud veteran of the United States Army, Martin carried himself with quiet dignity throughout his life. He dedicated 30 years of faithful service as a mail carrier with the United States Postal Service in Hackensack, New Jersey, retiring in 1997. Through rain, snow, and sunshine, he was a steady and familiar presence in the community he served.

Martin was a devoted parishioner of St. Mary's Church in Barnegat, where his faith remained an important part of his life.

A quiet and gentle soul, Martin found his greatest joys in simple pleasures. He loved fishing and spending time at the Jersey Shore, where the sound of the water brought him peace. He also enjoyed traveling, especially cruises, where he could explore new places while savoring the calm of the open sea.

He is survived by his loving sisters, Anna M. Unger and Katherine DeSalvo and her husband, Ronald. He was a cherished uncle to Kathryn A. Dzwilewski and her husband, David; Stephen Unger and his wife, Megan; Victor DeSalvo; and Jeff DeSalvo and his wife, Molly. He also leaves behind nine great-nieces and nephews, who will carry forward his memory with love.

Martin will be remembered for his quiet strength, steady work ethic, and kind heart. His life was one of devotion — to his family, his faith, his country, and his community. He will be deeply missed and forever held in the hearts of those who knew and loved him.
