



Stanislaw Olszowski

Stanislaw Olszowski, 82, of Greenville NY, passed on Sunday, April 14, 2024. Stanislaw was born in Wara, Poland and immigrated to the United States in 1965 with his wife Zofia. He lived in Wallington, NJ for many years before setting in Greenville, NY with his wife Helene where he spent his retirement. He was a certified Forest Ranger while living in Poland. He was self-taught in construction and carpentry and started Stanley & Walter Construction in Wallington with his brother-in-law. Stanislaw was a former parishioner of Most Sacred Heart of Jesus Church in Wallington and was a well-loved and popular figure in the Wallington Polish community.

He was an adventurous soul who loved to travel, visiting Bermuda, The Bahamas, Morocco, Jamaica, and Mexico, and often made trips back to his homeland of Poland. He loved to return with unique gifts from his travels to share with his family. In his retirement he remained a tireless worker, maintaining his beautiful property in upstate NY as an outdoor oasis. His love of carpentry and woodworking skills transformed his home into a sanctuary for native birds in the area, and he enjoyed maintaining vegetable and perennial gardens. He was an avid reader and immensely proud of his Polish heritage.

Stanislaw was the devoted husband of Helene Olszowski (nee Kwiatkowski) and her daughters Cynthia, Karen, and their families. He was the loving father of Danuta Wolak and her husband Joseph, Tadeusz Olszowski and his wife

Kathy, Linda Bitetto and her husband Joseph, and Urszula Olszowski, and caring grandfather of Isabella McArdel and her husband, Alex, Andrew Wolak and his wife Jordan, Matthew Wolak, Marcus Bitetto, Jacob Wolak, Ava Olszowski, Anthony Bitetto, and Lily Olszowski. He is survived by his sister Danuta in Poland. He is preceded in death by his first wife, Zofia Olszowski (nee Bednarz), his four brothers and parents.
