Stanley Gurak, 88, of Elmwood Park, died Friday, August 22, 2014. Born in Passaic, he lived in Elmwood Park his entire life. Prior to his retirement, Stanley was the plant manager for the Victory Baking Company in Jersey City for over 20 years. Previously he was employed at Federal Sweets in Clifton. Stanley was a veteran of the United States Army, serving as an aircraft gunner for the 505th Bomb Group, 482nd Bomb Squadron, flying 16 missions during the air offensive in Japan. He was awarded the Air Medal, World War II Victory Medal, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal, Distinguished Unit Badge with Oak Leaf Cluster, and Good Conduct Medal. Stanley was a member of the Elmwood Park Fire Department, Company 3, a former Secretary of the Relief Association, and former member of the Elmwood Park Planning Board. Stanley was the beloved husband of Rose (nee Terchanik), devoted father of Linda Russo, and her husband Joseph, of Oakland, and Susan LaGrasta, and her husband Damian, of Lodi, loving grandfather of Christian, Bryan, Damian, and Lauren, and great-grandson Grayson, dear brother of the late John and Joseph Gurak.
