



## Stephen J. Adzima

August 20, 1915 - May 21, 2017

Stephen Adzima Sr., born on August 20, 1915, spent his life in Wallington as a family guy, as well as an active parishioner at Saint Mary's RC Church in Passaic. He was educated at Washington Elementary School, and continued his education at Bloomfield Technical School studying in the field of electrical engineering. His successful career began at Manhattan Rubber as a draftsman, and later worked at Industrial Electrical in Hawthorne, NJ. As Stephen gained more experience in his work, he founded Universal Electric Motor Service in 1946. He was a longtime member of the Wallington Lions Club, Knights of Columbus Wallington Council 3644, Wallington Library Board, Wallington Board of Education and Union League Club. After being set up on a blind date with his late wife, Mary, they created a loving family of three children. Arlene and her husband Ed, of Nokomis, FL, Ron and Joan of Fort Lauderdale, FL and Stephen Jr. and his wife Roxanne of Wallington. Stephen was the loving grandfather of Ron Jr., Stephen III, Michael, Ryan, Jeff, Janet Lee, Veronica, Racquel, Sharon, and Cindy and Tim Kilkenny, and great-grandfather of Timmy, Brendan, Samantha, Allie, Katie, J. 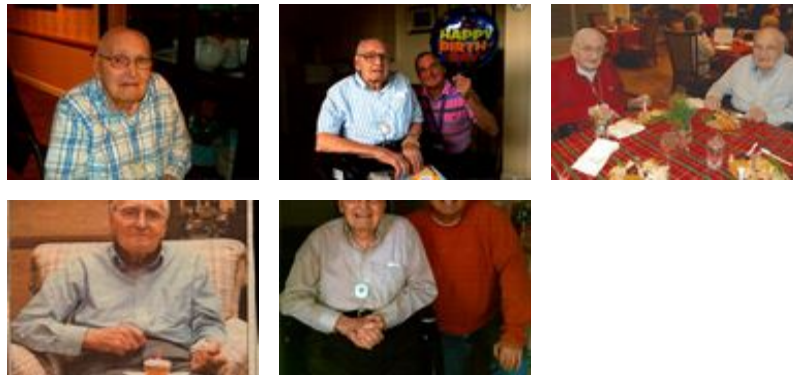
