



## Teddy Maciaszek

February 5, 1921 - July 23, 2015

Teddy Maciaszek, 94, of Garfield, passed away on Thursday, July 23, 2015. Born in Jersey City, Teddy lived in Garfield his entire life. Prior to his retirement in 1986, Teddy was a gardener for the Bergen County Park Commission in Garfield for 10 years. Previously he was a carpenter for numerous local construction companies, and had also been a weaver for the Gera Mills in Passaic. He was a veteran of the United States Army serving during WW II in the Western Pacific, Japan, and took part in the liberation of the Philippines, receiving the Asiatic-Pacific Theater Service Ribbon, Philippine Liberation Ribbon, and Victory Medal. Ted was also a member of the Garfield V.F.W. Bedna Roehrich Post 2867. Teddy was the beloved son of the late Karol and Mary (nee Gucwa) Maciaszek, dear brother of Alex Maciaszek and Helen Rychlicki, both of Garfield, and the late Walter, Joseph, and Wanda Maciaszek, loving uncle of Bruce Rych, James, Sandra, Valerie, Wanda, and Christine.
