Walter Wielgus, 94, of Clifton, passed on Wednesday, June 25, 2025. Walter was born in Nowe Zukowice, Tarnow, Poland. He graduated high school in 1949 and attended three years of college in Torun, two years of Philosophy and one year of Theology. In 1957, Walter left Poland for England. After three months he moved to Holland. From there he moved to Germany then France. He emigrated to the United States on May 23, 1959. He lived in New York, NY, then Wallington, NJ, and Garfield, NJ, before settling in Clifton, NJ in 1972. Walter was a self-employed house painter and an active parishioner of Holy Rosary R.C. Church in Passaic since 1960. On March 21, 1988, Walter was accepted as an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist by Bishop Frank Rodimer, Diocese of Paterson. He was also an honor guard usher at Holy Rosary. Walter was the Grand Marshall at the 2008 Pulaski Day Parade. He loved gardening. His organic tomatoes and cucumbers were treasured by his family. Walter enjoyed singing in church, playing the harmonica, and vacationing in Aruba. Walter was the beloved husband of the late Stella Sutula Wielgus, the devoted father of Stanley Wielgus and his wife, Marie, Walter Wielgus, Jr. and his wife, KarenMarie, Zigmund Wielgus, and Anna MacLaren, and her husband, Douglas, and the loving grandfather of Victoria Wielgus. He also leaves behind many loving cousins.
