Wanda Peters, beloved mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and cherished matriarch of her family, passed away peacefully on April 25, 2026, at the age of 89. Her life was one of devotion, resilience, kindness, and unwavering love for those closest to her.

Born on June 14, 1936, in the small village of Malków, Poland, Wanda was the beloved daughter of the late Jozef Staniszewski and the late Janina (Blaszczyk) Staniszewska.
